The Instructional Program

Session 1 – Skills Camp

Hitting, bunting, throwing, fielding, base-running, infield and outfield play, team defense

Session 2 – Pitcher/Catcher Camp

Pitchers: proper throwing mechanics, control pitching, various pitches, windup & stretch position mechanics, pick-off moves, pitching strategy

Catchers: stances, receiving the ball, swaying & framing, blocking balls in the dirt, throwing to all bases, foul flies, catching pitches, strategy

Campers will receive a skills checklist and written evaluation at the conclusion of the camp

Camp Director Bob Stevens has coached baseball since 1984. His experience includes Assistant Coach at Princeton University, Clifton High School, and at Scotch Plains-Fanwood High School, where he compiled a 161-72 record in 13 seasons as the JV and Varsity coach. Stevens played at Northern Valley Regional High School, where he was chosen as a USA High School All Star member versus Taiwan. He played varsity baseball at Montclair State University and East Stroudsburg University as well as on semi-pro teams in New Jersey Pennsylvania and Delaware.

Baseball Services is the company Stevens founded in 1987 that has offered private lessons, fall baseball leagues, winter baseball sessions, coach’s clinics and full service summer camps. He also pioneered the marketing of video baseball batting cages in the early 1990s, now seen at many major league ballparks.

Camp instructors include varsity and JV high school coaches from various New Jersey high schools, all with coaching and playing experience.
